

# Jesus – Our Rest and Jubilee



**Hebrews 10:1** For the law, having a shadow of the good things to come, *and not the very image of the things*, can never with these same sacrifices, which they offer continually year by year, make those who approach perfect...

**5** Therefore, when He came into the world, He said:

“Sacrifice and offering You did not desire,  
But a body You have prepared for Me.

**6** In burnt offerings and *sacrifices* for sin

You had no pleasure.**7** Then I said, ‘Behold, I have come—

*In the volume of the book it is written of Me—*

To do Your will, O God.’



**Hebrews 10:11** And every priest stands ministering daily and offering repeatedly the same sacrifices, which can never take away sins. **12** But this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, **sat down at the right hand of God**, **13** from that time waiting till His enemies are made His footstool. **14** For by one offering He has perfected forever those who are being sanctified.

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**Hebrews 11:1** Now faith (pistis – belief) is the substance of things hoped for, the evidence of things not seen.

- The Law was a shadow of good things to come
- Faith, or belief that Jesus has done all these things for you, is the real thing



**Leviticus 25:8** ‘And you shall count seven sabbaths of years for yourself, seven times seven years; and the time of the seven sabbaths of years shall be to you forty-nine years.

**9** Then you shall cause the trumpet of the Jubilee to sound on the tenth *day* of the seventh month; on the Day of Atonement you shall make the trumpet to sound throughout all your land. **10** And you shall consecrate the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout *all* the land to all its inhabitants. It shall be a Jubilee for you; and each of you shall return to his possession, and each of you shall return to his family.



**Leviticus 25:25** 'If one of your brethren becomes poor, and has sold *some* of his possession, and if his redeeming relative comes to redeem it, then he may redeem what his brother sold. **26** Or if the man has no one to redeem it, but he himself becomes able to redeem it, **27** then let him count the years since its sale, and restore the remainder to the man to whom he sold it, that he may return to his possession. **28** But if he is not able to have *it* restored to himself, then what was sold shall remain in the hand of him who bought it until the Year of Jubilee; and in the Jubilee it shall be released, and he shall return to his possession.



**When the people observed the Sabbath rest and Jubilee, God promised to command the blessing on them**

**- You were returned to your family**

**- All debts were cleared, and if you lost any of your inheritance, it was given back to you**



**Leviticus 25:9** Then you shall cause the trumpet (showfar) of the Jubilee (**teruah**) to sound on the tenth *day* of the seventh month; on the Day of Atonement you shall make the trumpet to sound throughout all your land. **10** And you shall consecrate the fiftieth year, and proclaim liberty throughout *all* the land to all its inhabitants.

Jubilee – Teruah – shout, blast of a trumpet  
From the root rua – shout of triumph or victory





**Luke 4:17** And He was handed the book of the prophet Isaiah. And when He had opened the book, He found the place where it was written:

**18** “The Spirit of the Lord *is* upon Me,  
Because He has anointed Me  
To preach the gospel to *the* poor;  
He has sent Me to heal the brokenhearted,  
To proclaim liberty to *the* captives  
And recovery of sight to *the* blind,  
To set at liberty those who are oppressed;

**19** To proclaim the acceptable year of the Lord.”



**John 19:30** So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, “It is finished!” And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.

**Jesus blood was shed, and He proclaimed jubilee**

**You have been restored to your original inheritance, all debts have been cleared, God has commanded the blessing on you!**



**How can you tell if you are at rest?**

**Are you striving, praying, fighting the enemy in order to get God to do something for you?**

**Galatians 3:5** He therefore that ministereth to you the Spirit, and worketh miracles among you, doeth he it by the works of the law, or by the hearing of faith?



**God wants us to rest in His works, not our works.**

**When a trial comes, we can stay in rest and enjoy His supernatural flow of provision.**

**“Father, I’m trusting in you that this has already been taken care of.”**
